- Sexual and Emotional

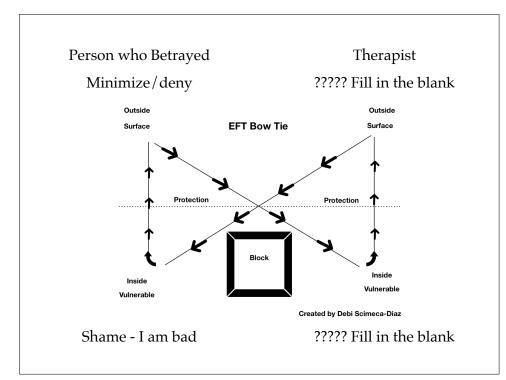


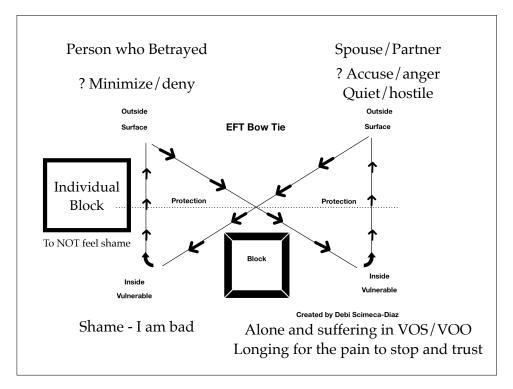

Be curious about ourselves

- How does our life experience impact us?
- What did you learn about affairs growing up?
- Did someone you love have an affair (parent or partner)
- Have you had an affair?
- What did you learn about sex?
- Notice if you have an internal judgements about affairs.







The best thing you can do is process this with a supervisor you trust

Key Points

- Must validate and support betrayed partner
- Must have good alliance with BOTH
- Must put affair in the cycle: while not lessening responsibility
- Must Identify pre affair and post affair cycles
- Must hold the hope in the darkness and pain

Sometimes our clients can't get past the affair If this happens, our job is to help them share vulnerably that they can't forgive no matter what the partner says or does
